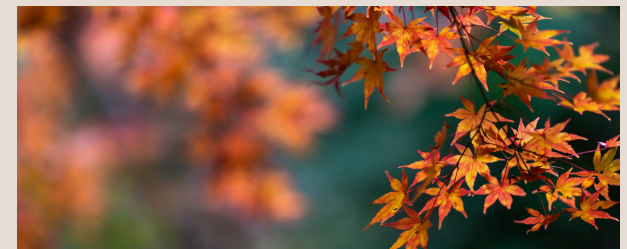
Anyone who is interested in this project is invited to a meeting in the Limerick Diocesan Centre , on Tuesday 8 October at 7 30 pm.

Alpha Course

This course explores the basics of life from a Christian perspective. It is an opportunity to ask and discuss life's most important questions in a non-judgemental friendly and safe environment. It explores the components of Christian faith. The course is designed for all adults, particularly those who do not normally attend church, but believe that they are spiritual and may wish for a place to share their beliefs in a non-threatening environment. The course consists of a short introduction session, a video presentation and then small group discussion on the topics raised. If you would be interested please register, as places are limited.
